



Seminar report on textile knowledge

"Textile Knowledge: Understanding different Fabrics and their Properties"

Introduction:

On 13th of October 2023, our college hosted a seminar titled "Textile Knowledge: Understanding Different Fabrics and Their Properties," featuring Shweta Raju Wanjare, assistant professor, Tulsi College of Fashion Design as the keynote speaker. The seminar was tailored for college students studying fashion design, aiming to enhance their understanding of fabric types and their applications.

Summary of the Presentation:

Shweta Raju Wanjare's keynote address was both informative and engaging, covering several key aspects of textile knowledge:

Fabric Types and Classification: Wanjare began by categorizing fabrics into natural and synthetic types. She provided detailed descriptions of common fabrics such as cotton, wool, silk, polyester and nylon explaining their origins, manufacturing processes and typical uses.

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


